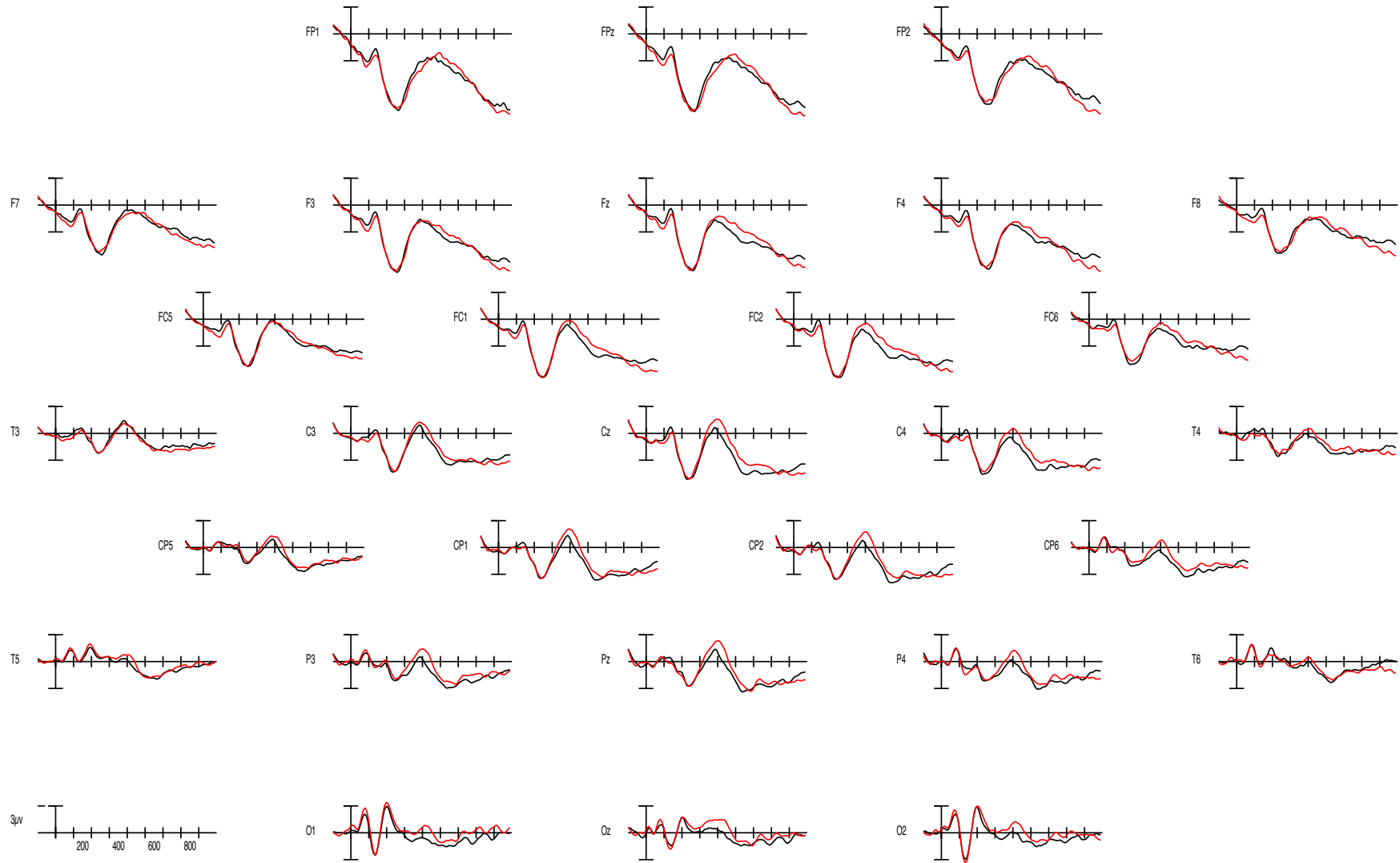


Supplementary figures for “Dissociating N400 effects of prediction from association in single word contexts.”

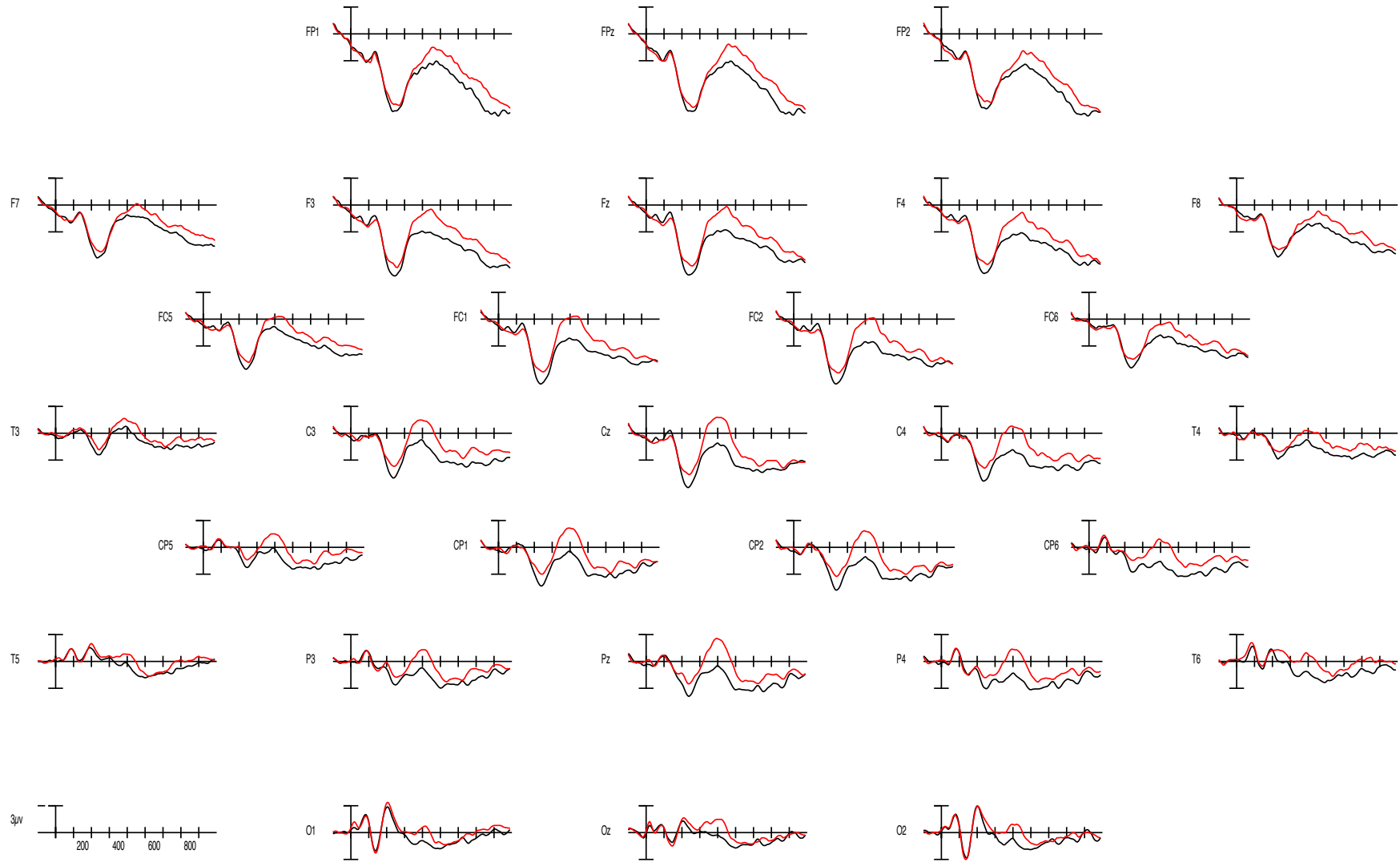

The following six figures provide the full electrode montage data for all the pairwise comparisons discussed in the paper. The first five figures illustrate the time-locked response to the second word of a prime-target pair (-100:900 ms), while the last figure illustrates the time-locked response to the prime word itself (-100:600 ms).



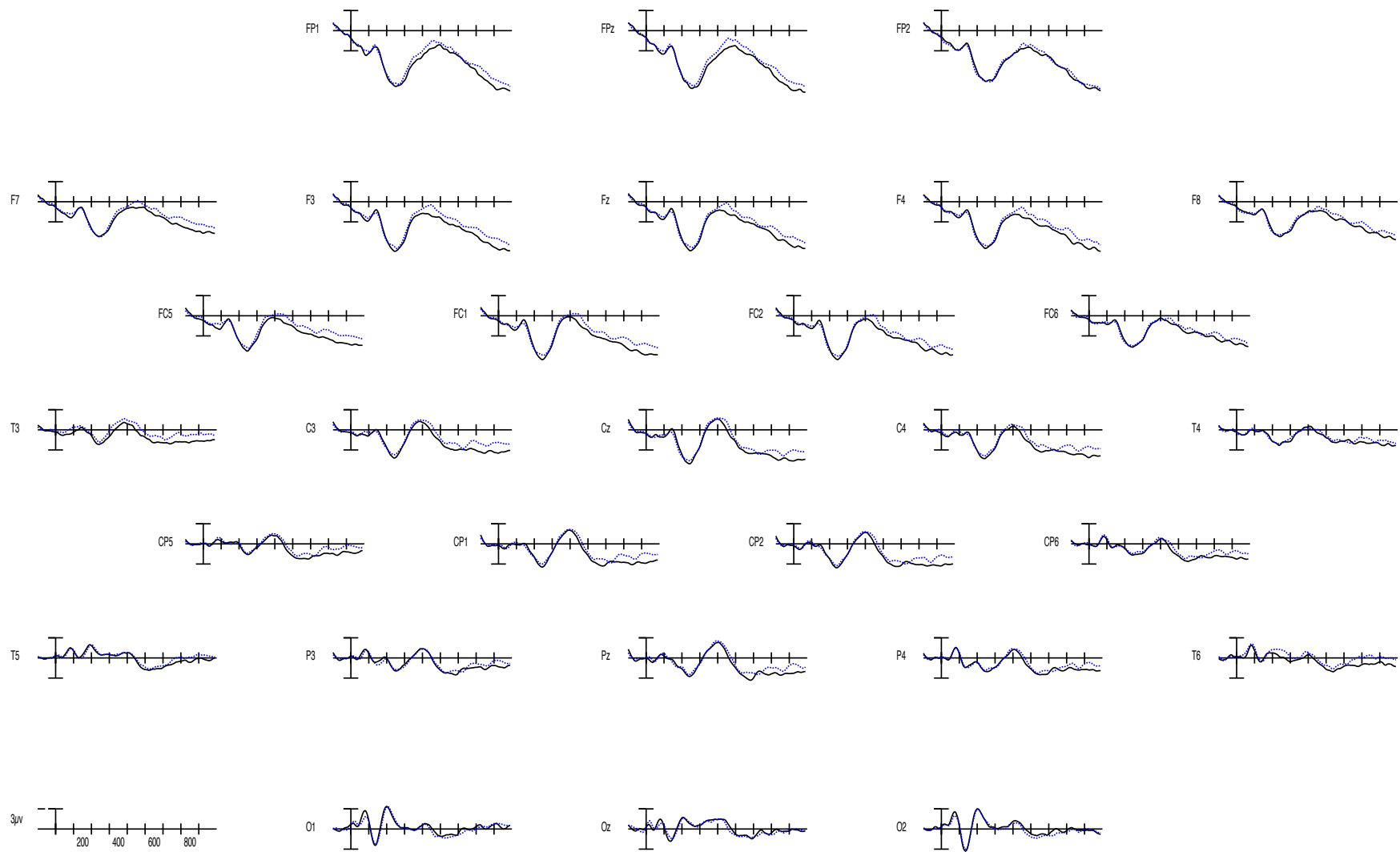
All Responses

 — unrelated, low proportion



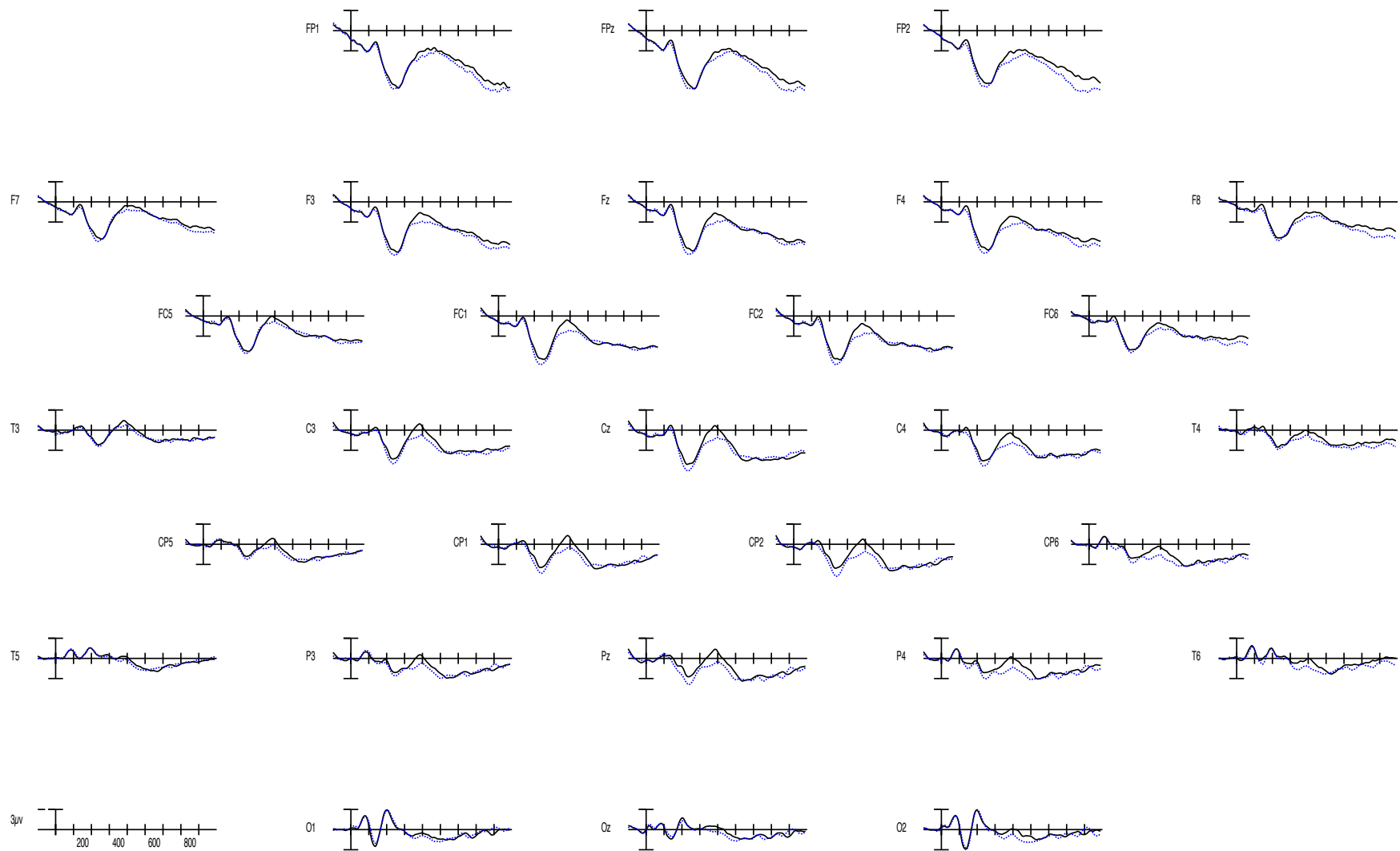
All Responses

 — unrelated, high proportion



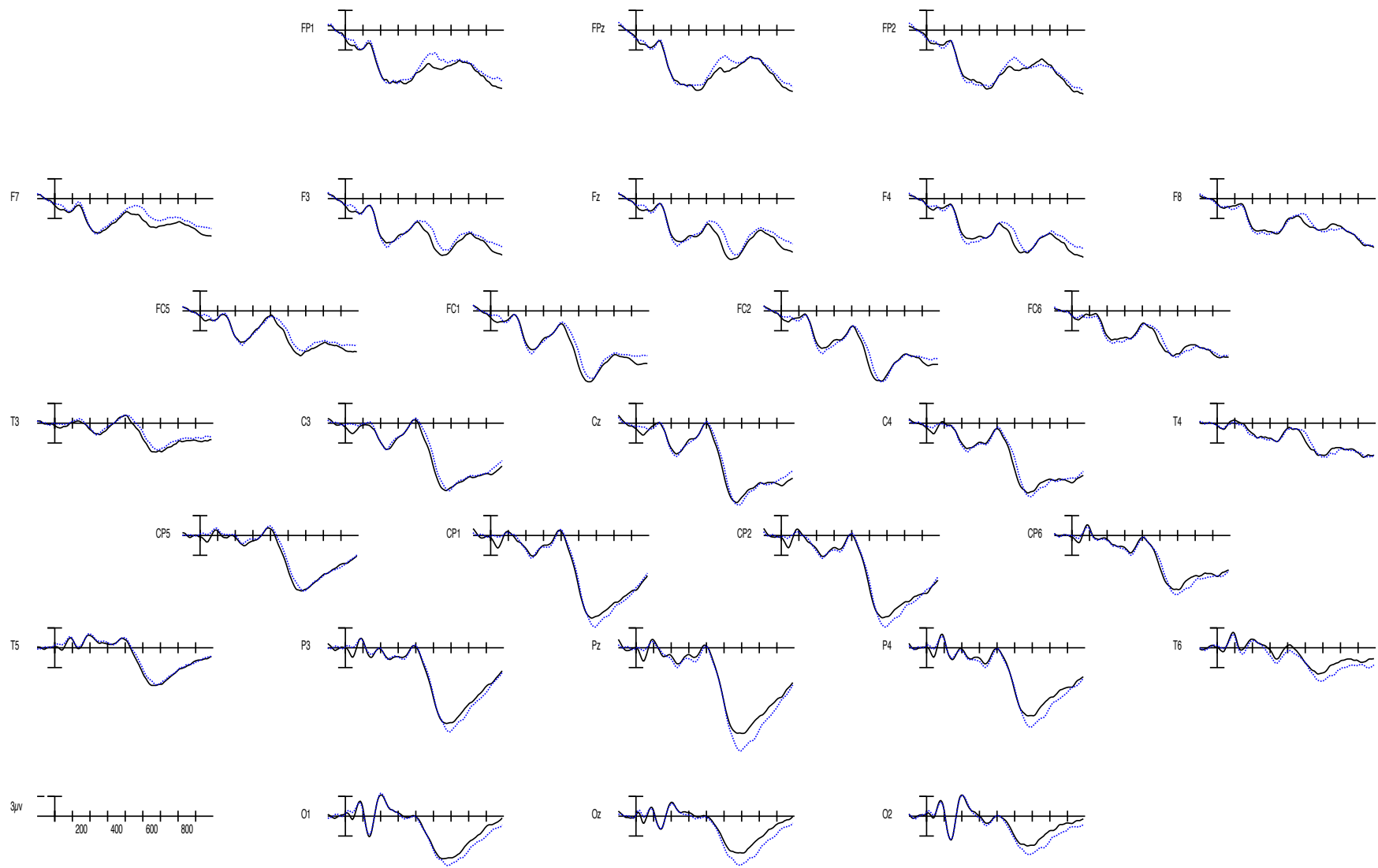

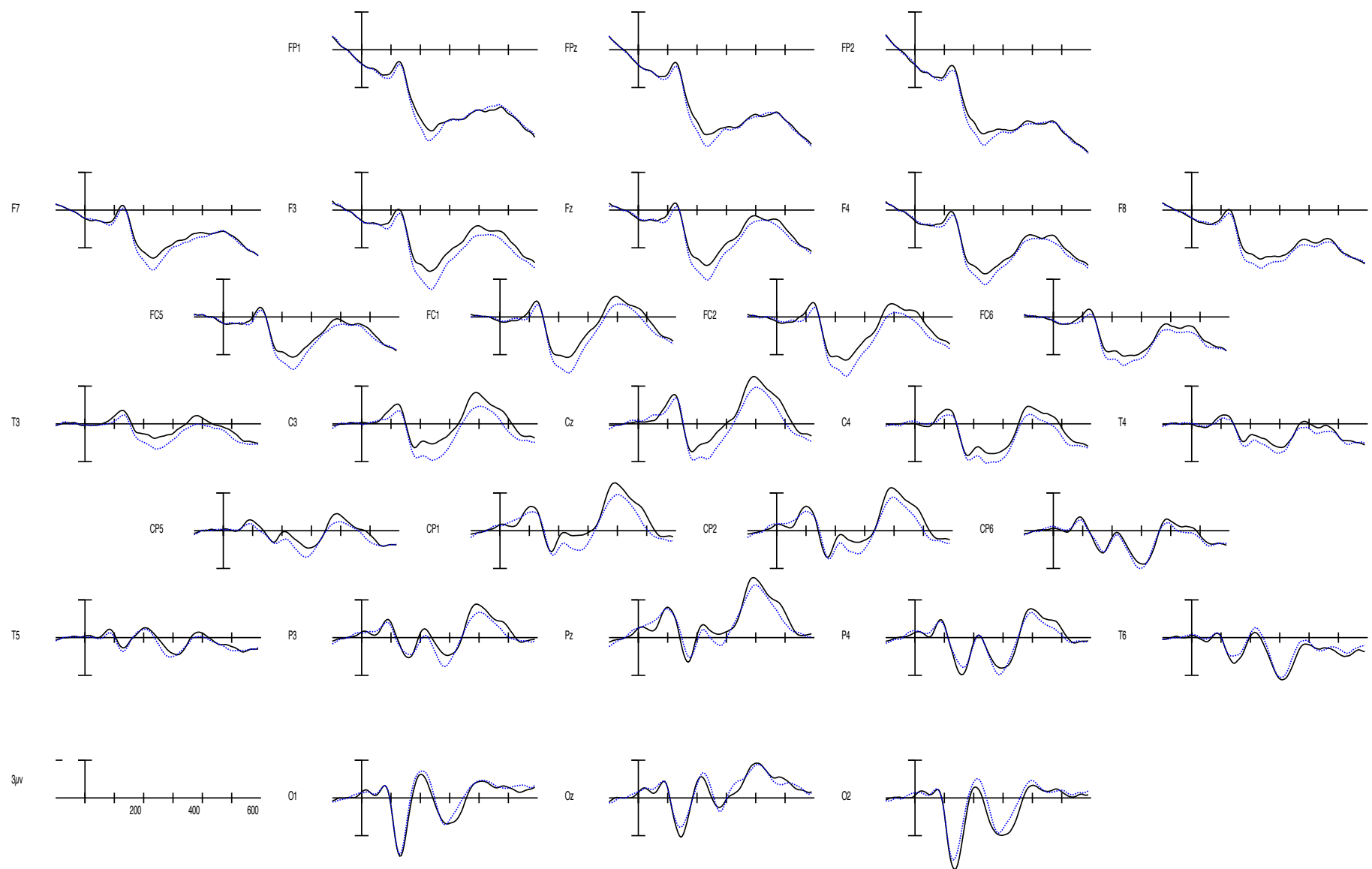
